## **DECISION**

Concerning the Working Language for the Referral of Revised Rules of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence Pursuant to Article 19(5) of the Law

THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT PANEL, assigned pursuant to Article 33(3) of Law No. 05/L-053 on Specialist Chambers and Specialist Prosecutor's Office (the 'Law') and acting pursuant to Article 20 of the Law, hereby decides the working language for the proceedings before it.

- On 31 May 2017, revised rules of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence adopted on 29 May 2017 by remote voting by the Specialist Chambers Judges, except for the Judges of the Specialist Chamber of the Constitutional Court, were referred to the Specialist Chamber of the Constitutional Court pursuant to Article 19(5) of the Law.
- 2. Article 20 of the Law provides that '[i]n any given proceedings, ... a Panel may decide the working languages for those proceedings'.

FOR THESE REASONS, and in accordance with Article 20 of the Law,

## THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT PANEL HEREBY

**decides** that the working language for the proceedings concerning the referral of revised rules of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence pursuant to Article 19(5) of the Law shall be **English**.
