

Notice of Decision by the High Representative to Lift the Ban Imposed on Jusuf Zahiragić by the High Representative Decision dated 29 November 1999

76/14

The High Representative by way of his Decision dated 29 November 1999 (“the 1999 Decision”) removed Mr. Jusuf Zahiragić from his position of Minister of Justice of Canton Sarajevo. This Decision also barred Mr. Zahiragić from holding any executive office at any level (“Ban”) unless authorised to do so. The 1999 Decision further provided for its review by the High Representative.

Upon consideration of Mr. Zahiragić’s case, I have decided to repeal the Ban. Mr. Jusuf Zahiragić is no longer barred by decision of the High Representative from holding any executive office at any level. For the avoidance of any doubt, any ban arising out of the 1999 Decision is hereby lifted.

The principles of equity, proper governance and judicious exercise of the High Representative’s international mandate, all of which take into account the balance between the protection of national stability and the rights of the individual, justify this outcome.

This Decision does not call into question the validity of the 1999 Decision. This Decision does not entitle Mr. Zahiragić to restoration to the office from which he was removed pursuant to the 1999 Decision. Further, this Decision does not entitle him to compensation for any remuneration, other forms of unvested monetary benefits or privileges or status forfeited as a result of the 1999 Decision.

This Decision does not constitute an amnesty but rather a repeal, prospectively, of the 1999 Decision. The latter is not expunged and remains as part of the legislative record of Bosnia and Herzegovina.

This Decision does not affect or otherwise prejudice any pending or impending legal proceedings in or outside of Bosnia and Herzegovina.

To the extent the terms of this Decision contradict domestic legislation on any of the subjects encompassed thereby, the former shall prevail. High Representative Decisions supersede and preempt contradictory domestic legislation. This legislative statement is declaratory of existing and prospective High Representative Decisions.

This Decision has immediate effect and will not require any further procedural steps.

This Decision shall be published without delay in the Official Gazette of Bosnia and Herzegovina.
