RECALLING Motion for Termination of Enforcement of Sentence in the United Kingdom and for Transfer to Rwanda, filed by Counsel for Mr. Charles Ghankay Taylor, on 13 June 2014 ("Motion");

GRANTS the Application for Leave, and Orders that the Prosecutor re-files its Submissions in Response to the Motion with the Court Management Section no later than 15 July 2014.
