## DECISION TO ASSIGN COUNSEL TO MORRIS GALLON

## THE PRINCIPAL DEFENDER

CONSIDERING the Statute of the Residual Special Court for Sierra Leone and in particular Article 23 thereof;

CONSIDERING the Rules of Procedure and Evidence as adopted by the plenary meeting of the Residual Special Court as amended on the $4^{\text {th }}$ December 2013;

CONSIDERING the Directive on the Assignment of Counsel as adopted by the Registrar on the $1^{\text {st }}$ October 2003 and in particular Article 13 thereof;

CONSIDERING that Mr. Morris Kallon a Special Court for Sierra Leone Convict is presently serving his jail term in Nyanza Prison, Rwanda pursuant to an Order of the Special Court for Sierra Leone;

CONSIDERING that Mr. Morris Kallon has informed the Residual Special Court for Sierra Leone of his desire to appoint one Counsel of his choice namely Chief Charles Taku from Cameroon;

CONSIDERING that Chief Taku has consented to represent Mr. Morris Hassan Kallon pro bono by virtue of an agreement between Mr. Kallon and the within named Counsel to which the Residual Special Court is not a party;


CONSIDERING that the Principal Defender of the Residual Special Court may assign Counsel in the interests of justice, to represent a Convict;

HEREBY DIRECTS the assignment of Chief Charles Taku as Counsel to Mr. Morris Kallon as of the $10^{\text {th }}$ May 2018.
