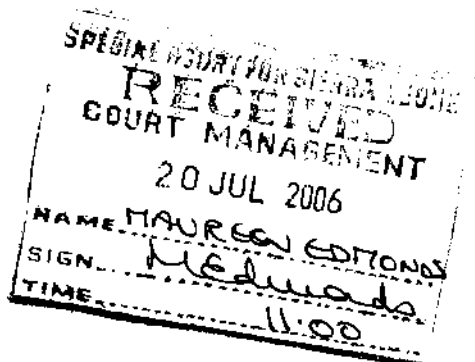

NOTING the Scheduling Order for Status Conference in the Hague, dated 17 July 2006, which orders a Status Conference to be held on Friday, 21 July 2006 at 11.30 a.m. at the International Criminal Court at The Hague, The Netherlands, in Courtroom 1 before Justice Richard Lussick;



PURSUANT to Rule 81(D) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence ("the Rules");


ORDERS AS FOLLOWS

1. That Mr Rob Kerris is authorised to be present in Courtroom 1 on 21 July 2006;
2. That he be allocated a position in the Courtroom 15 minutes before the start of the court proceedings;
3. That he is granted permission to photograph from inside the Courtroom immediately after the court is seated and for a period of 1 minute;
4. That he is to ensure that the dignity of the proceedings is preserved;
5. That as the only photographer that will access the courtroom, he agrees to make available the photographs taken to the press in Sierra Leone and international press;
6. That he supplies the Press and Public Affairs Office of the Special Court with a selection of pictures so taken for internal use.
