

TRIAL CHAMBER II ("Trial Chamber") of the Special Court for Sierra Leone ("Special Court"), composed of Justice Richard Lussick, presiding, Justice Teresa Doherty and Justice Julia Sebutinde;

RECALLING the President's Order Assigning a Case to a Trial Chamber of 31 March 2006 and the President's Order Changing Venue of Proceedings of 19 June 2006;

RECALLING the first Status Conference held on Friday, 21 July 2006 at the International Criminal Court at the Hague, the Netherlands before Justice Richard Lussick at which it was proposed that a second Status Conference be held during the month of September 2006;

PURSUANT TO Rule 65bis of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the Special Court ("Rules");

HEREBY CONVENES a second Status Conference to be held on Friday, 22 September 2006 at 2.00 p.m. at the International Criminal Court at The Hague, The Netherlands, in Courtroom 1 before Justice Julia Sebutinde;

AND ORDERS

Case No. SCSL-03-01-PT

- 1. That the preliminary agenda for the second Status Conference shall include the following:
 - (i) An update from the Parties on compliance with disclosure obligations under Rule 66, Rule 67 and Rule 68 of the Rules;
 - (ii) An indication of the composition of the Prosecution and Defence teams;
 - (iii) An indication from the Parties as to any points of agreement, including admissions or statements not in dispute and agreed issues; and
 - (iv) Any additional issues that the Parties or Court may wish to raise in relation to the case.
- 2. That the parties submit proposed agenda items, if any, by Friday 15 September 2006.
