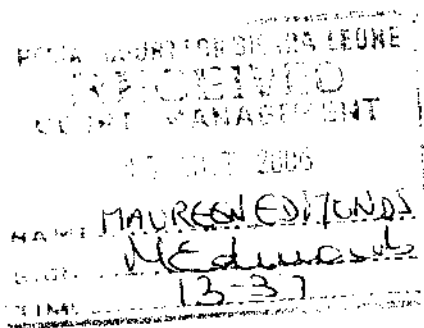

SEISED OF the Confidential Prosecution Motion for Leave to Call Evidence in Rebuttal, filed on 16 October 2006 ("Motion"), wherein the Prosecution seeks leave to call witnesses in rebuttal at the conclusion of the Defence case and, if granted, immediate protective measures for the proposed rebuttal witnesses;

CONSIDERING that it is in the interest of a fair and expeditious trial to expedite the filings of any written submissions to the Motion;


PURSUANT to Rules 7(C), 26bis and 54 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the Special Court;


HEREBY ORDERS as follows:
