

I, Justice Julia Sebutinde, Presiding Judge of Trial Chamber II of the Special Court for Sierra Leone ("Special Court");

RECALLING that in accordance with Article 2 of the Agreement Between the United Nations and the Government of Sierra Leone on the Establishment of a Special Court for Sierra Leone, ("Agreement")¹ and Article 12 of the Statute of the Special Court ("Statute") H. E. Ban Ki-Moon, Secretary General of the United Nations did in his letter dated 25 April 2007 appoint the Honourable Justice El Hadji Malick Sow as an alternate judge of Trial Chamber II of the Special Court for a period of three years commencing on 10 May 2007;

NOTING the provisions of Article 2.5 of the Agreement and of Article 12.4 of the Statute that-

"If at the request of the President of the Special Court, an alternate judge or judges have been appointed by the Government of Sierra Leone or the Secretary General, the presiding judge of a Trial Chamber or the Appeals Chamber shall designate such an alternate judge to be present at each stage of the trial and to replace a judge if that judge is unable to continue sitting";

NOTING also the provisions of Rules 16 and 16bis of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence;

PURSUANT to Article 12.4 of the Statute;

HEREBY DESIGNATES Justice El Hadji Malick Sow, to be present at each stage of the trial of the Accused Charles Ghankay Taylor² and to replace a judge if that judge is unable to continue sitting.
