**TRIAL CHAMBER II** ("Trial Chamber") of the Special Court for Sierra Leone ("Special Court"), composed of Justice Julia Sebutinde, Presiding Judge, Justice Richard Lussick and Justice Teresa Doherty;

**NOTING** the Judgement rendered against the Accused Brima, Kamara and Kanu on 20 June 2007, wherein the Trial Chamber found each of the Accused guilty on counts 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 9, 10, 12, 13 and 14 of the Indictment;<sup>1</sup>

**NOTING** that Rule 100(B) states

[...] Where the accused has been convicted by a Trial Chamber, the Trial Chamber may hear submissions of the parties at a sentencing hearing. [emphasis added]

**NOTING** the oral order of the Trial Chamber on 20 June 2007 stating that

[...] each of the three Accused is remanded until Monday, 16 July 2007, at 11.00 a.m. for a sentencing hearing. [...] The parties are reminded of their obligations pursuant to Rule 100 of the Rules to submit relevant information, if they wish, that may assist the Trial Chamber in determining appropriate sentences in respect of the convictions entered;<sup>2</sup>

**NOTING** the Prosecution Submission Pursuant to Rule 100(A) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, filed 28 June 2007 ("Prosecution Sentencing Brief")<sup>3</sup>; the Brima - Defence Submission Pursuant to Rule 100(A) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, filed 5 July 2007 ("Brima Sentencing Brief")<sup>4</sup>; the Kamara Sentencing Brief Pursuant to Rule 100(A) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, filed 5 July 2007 ("Kamara Sentencing Brief")<sup>5</sup>; the Kanu Sentencing Brief Pursuant to 100(A) and Request for Non-Admission of Prosecution Exhibits, filed 5 July 2007 ("Kanu Sentencing Brief")<sup>6</sup>;

**CONSIDERING** that this is an appropriate case for the Trial Chamber to exercise its discretion pursuant to Rule 100(B) of the Rules to hear submissions of the Parties at a sentencing hearing;

**PURSUANT** to the provisions of Rules 54 and 100 of the Rules;

**HEREBY ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. that the Sentencing Hearing be held on 16 July 2007 at 9:30 a.m.;
2. the length of the sentencing submissions for the Prosecution shall not exceed one hour and that the sentencing submissions of Counsel for each Accused person shall not exceed one hour;
3. that the Sentencing Judgement be rendered on 19 July 2007, at 11:30 a.m.


