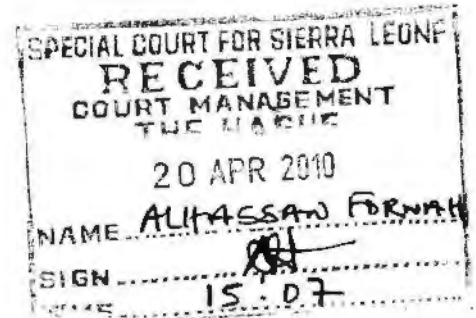

TRIAL CHAMBER II ("Trial Chamber") of the Special Court for Sierra Leone ("Special Court");

PURSUANT to Rules 7(C), 26bis, and 54 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence ("Rules");


HEREBY ORDERS as follows:

- (3) Court Management Services shall ensure immediate distribution to the Parties and the Trial Chamber of hard copies of this Order and of any response or reply;


