- On 1 July 2010, the Taylor Defence filed the "Motion to Exclude Custodial Statements of Issa Sesay". On 12 July 2010, the Prosecution responded by filing the "Prosecution Response to Defence Motion to Exclude Custodial Statements of Issa Sesay" ("Response"). The Defence filed its Reply to the Response on 19 July 2010.
- 2. It has come to the attention of the Prosecution that there is an editorial error in paragraph 17 of the Response. The fifth sentence of paragraph 17 states: "Because under Rule 2, a person ceases to be a suspect once indicted, by definition, Accused persons are a sub-set of suspects." This sentence should read as follows: "Because under Rule 2, a person does not cease to be a suspect once indicted, by definition, Accused persons are a sub-set of suspects."
