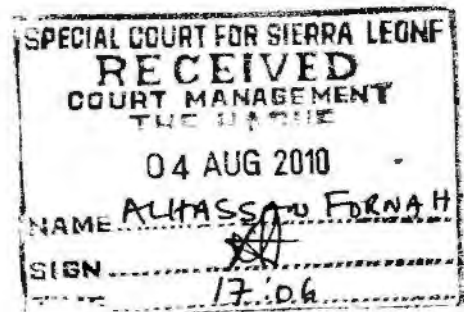

TRIAL CHAMBER II ("Trial Chamber") of the Special Court for Sierra Leone ("Special Court");

CONSIDERING the request of the Press and Outreach Officer of the Special Court to permit Mr. Vincent Jannink of the Associated Press Photo Department in Amsterdam, The Netherlands, to enter the courtroom in order to photograph the proceedings on 5 August 2010;


PURSUANT to Rule 81(D) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence ("the Rules");

ORDERS by majority, Justice Doherty dissenting, as follows:

1. That Mr. Vincent Jannink of the Associated Press Photo Department in Amsterdam, The Netherlands, is authorised to be present in the Courtroom on 5 August 2010;
2. That he be allocated a position in the Courtroom 15 minutes before the start of the proceedings;
3. That he is granted permission to photograph from inside the Courtroom immediately after the court is seated and for a period of 1 minute;
4. That he is to ensure that the dignity of the proceedings is preserved;
5. That as the only photographer that will access the courtroom, he agrees to make available the photographs taken to the press in Sierra Leone and international press;
6. That he supplies the Press and Public Affairs Office of the Special Court with a selection of pictures so taken for internal use.
