

**TRIAL CHAMBER II** (“Trial Chamber”) of the Special Court for Sierra Leone (“Special Court”);

**RECALLING** the “Order for Expedited Filing”, filed on 3 August 2010 (“Order”),<sup>1</sup> wherein the Trial Chamber granted Mr. Daniel R. Bright, legal representative for Ms. Carole White, leave to file a Motion and ordered an expedited filing schedule in respect of any responses thereto;

**SEISED** of the “Motion for Right to Appear as Counsel to a Witness”, filed on 3 August 2010 (“Motion”),<sup>2</sup> wherein Mr. Bright, seeks a right of appearance during the course of Ms. White’s anticipated testimony<sup>3</sup> in order to safeguard Ms. White’s interests;<sup>4</sup>

**NOTING** that Mr. Bright seeks only to be present in the courtroom so that he can directly observe his client while she testifies and so that Ms. White will be able to see his presence;<sup>5</sup>

**NOTING** the “Prosecution Response to Public Motion for Right to Appear as Counsel to a Witness” filed on 4 August 2010 (“Prosecution Response”),<sup>6</sup> wherein the Prosecution does not oppose the Motion;<sup>7</sup>

**NOTING** that the Defence did not file a Response to the Motion;

**COGNAISANT** of Rules 26bis, 54 and 73 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the Special Court (“Rules”);

**FINDING** in that it is in the interests of justice to grant the right of appearance to Mr. Daniel R. Bright during the course of Ms. White’s testimony;
