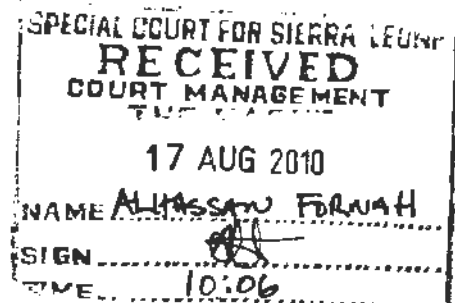

TRIAL CHAMBER II ("Trial Chamber") of the Special Court for Sierra Leone ("Special Court");¹

SEISED of the "Public Urgent Application for Leave to Appeal Decision Excluding the Use of Custodial Statement of Issa Sesay", filed on 16 August 2010 ("Urgent Motion"),² wherein the Prosecution, *inter alia*, seeks an expedited filing schedule in view of the advanced stage of the evidence of Mr. Sesay;³

NOTING that Mr. Sesay is currently testifying and that the Prosecution indicated that it would finalise its cross-examination by 3 September 2010, at the latest;⁴

CONSIDERING, therefore, that an expedited timetable for filings is warranted;


FOR THE ABOVE REASONS, THE TRIAL CHAMBER

GRANTS the Urgent Motion; and

ORDERS that:

- (1) Any Response by the Defence shall be filed no later than 16:00 on Thursday, 19 August 2010;
- (2) Any Reply to the Response by the Prosecution shall be filed no later than 17:00 on Friday, 20 August 2010.
