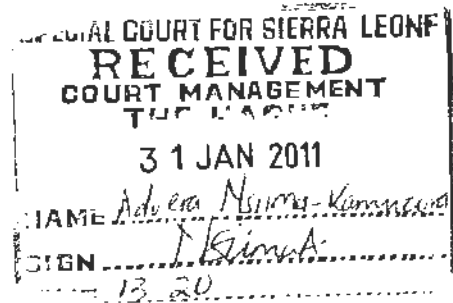

TRIAL CHAMBER II ("Trial Chamber") of the Special Court for Sierra Leone ("Special Court"), sitting pursuant to Rule 16 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence ("Rules");¹


CONSIDERING the request of the Press and Outreach Officer of the Special Court to permit Mr. Jerry Lampen of the Reuters News Agency in Rotterdam, The Netherlands, to photograph the proceedings on 8 February 2011;

PURSUANT to Rule 81(D) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence ("the Rules");

ORDERS AS FOLLOWS

1. That Mr. Jerry Lampen of Reuters News Agency in Rotterdam, The Netherlands, is authorised to be present in the Courtroom on 8 February 2011;
2. That he be allocated a position in the Courtroom 10 minutes before the start of the court proceedings;
3. That he is granted permission to photograph from inside the Courtroom immediately after the court is seated and for a period of 1 minute;
4. That he is to ensure that the dignity of the proceedings is preserved;
5. That as the only photographer that will access the courtroom, he agrees to make available the photographs taken to the press in Sierra Leone and international press;
6. That he supplies the Press and Public Affairs Office of the Special Court with all pictures so taken for internal use.
