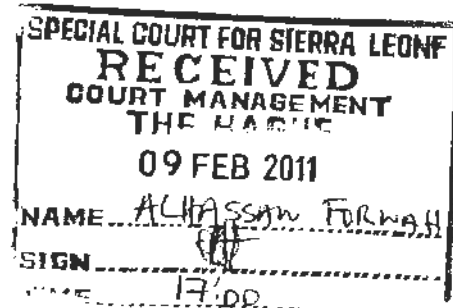

TRIAL CHAMBER II (“Trial Chamber”) of the Special Court for Sierra Leone (“Special Court”);

SEISED of the “Public with Confidential Annexes A to E & Public Annex F Urgent Prosecution Motion for an Investigation into Contempt of the Special Court for Sierra Leone”, filed on 3 February 2011 (“First Contempt Motion”),¹ wherein the Prosecution alleges contemptuous conduct by certain persons and requests an expedited filing schedule due to the serious nature of the allegations and the fact that they provide evidence of a concerted course of actions against Prosecution witnesses in Sierra Leone, and indicate that similar actions may be occurring in Liberia;²

SEISED ALSO of the “Public with Confidential Annexes A & B Urgent Prosecution Motion for an Investigation into Contempt of the Special Court for Sierra Leone”, filed on 7 February 2011 (“Second Contempt Motion”),³ wherein the Prosecution alleges contemptuous conduct by certain persons and requests an expedited filing schedule due to the serious nature of the allegations and the fact that they provide evidence of a concerted course of actions against Prosecution witnesses;⁴

CONSIDERING that given the allegations that there is a concerted course of action against Prosecution witnesses, an expedited timetable for filings is warranted;

PURSUANT to Rules 7(C), 26bis, and 54 of the Rules;

HEREBY ORDERS:

(1) in relation to the First Contempt Motion that:

- a. Any Response by the Defence shall be filed no later than 16:00 on Friday, 11 February 2011;
- b. Any Reply to the Response by the Prosecution shall be filed no later than 16:00 on Monday, 14 February 2011.

(2) in relation to the Second Contempt Motion that:

- a. Any Response by the Defence shall be filed no later than 16:00 on Monday, 14 February 2011;



(3) Any Reply to the Response by the Prosecution shall be filed no later than 16:00 on Wednesday, 16 February 2011,


