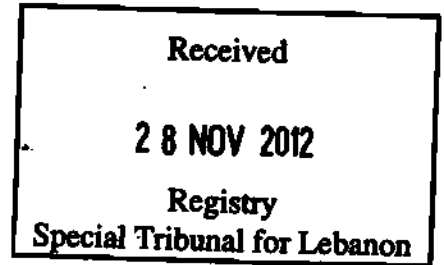

1. On 10 October 2012, the Pre-Trial Judge was seized of a request from Mr El Sayed (“the Applicant”) for certification for a partial appeal of the “Decision Setting a Deadline for the Prosecutor to Disclose to Mr El Sayed the Documents Mentioned in the Pre-Trial Judge’s Order of 12 May 2011” (“the Decision of 8 October 2012”) (“the Request”). On 11 October 2012, the Applicant seized the Appeals Chamber with a partial appeal of the Decision of 8 October 2012.

2. On 23 November 2012, the Appeals Chamber declared the partial appeal admissible and unfounded.

3. As a consequence, the Request is groundless.

FOR THESE REASONS,

Pursuant to Rule 77 of the Rules,

THE PRE-TRIAL JUDGE,

DECLARES the Request groundless.
