On 15 November 2013, the Prosecution filed a motion¹ to which any Defence responses are due by 27 November 2013, and any Prosecution reply by 29 November 2013.² The Prosecution has requested to file its anticipated reply in a consolidated format with a word limit commensurate to the number of responses that the reply is addressing (i.e., each response permits 2,000 words in reply).³ No Defence responses were filed.


FOR THESE REASONS, the Trial Chamber:

EXTENDS the word limit for a consolidated Prosecution reply to a level commensurate with the number of Defence responses filed, not to exceed 8,000 words.




