


On 28 November 2013, in its 'Decision Authorising the Prosecution to Redact a *Curriculum Vitae*', the Trial Chamber authorised the Prosecution to redact certain information from a *curriculum vitae* under Rule 116 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence. Shortly after filing this decision, an official of the Special Tribunal's Court Management Services Section brought to the Trial Chamber's attention the fact that the Prosecution had already disclosed the redacted information to the Defence in November 2012. This decision is therefore redundant.


