

- (iii) Prosecution motion under Rule 124 for testimony by video-link (PRH-261);
- (iv) Prosecution motion under Rule 158 concerning an unavailable witness;
- (v) Submissions from the parties under Rule 130 on the conduct of trial proceedings;
- (vi) Procedure for receiving documents into evidence at trial;
- (vii) Prosecution motion to reclassify a previously confidential filing;
- (viii) Issues of State cooperation;
- (ix) Possible joinder of the case of *Prosecutor v. Merhi*; and
- (x) Submissions from the parties concerning effective disclosure (OCR).


