1. The Trial Chamber, having ordered the Parties in the two cases, *Prosecutor v. Salim Jamil Ayyash, Mustafa Amine Badreddine, Hussein Hassan Oneissi and Assad Hassan Sabra* and *Prosecutor v. Hassan Habib Merhi*, to complete their filing of any submissions on the issue of the possible joinder of the cases by Tuesday 4 February 2014,<sup>1</sup> schedules a joint hearing on this issue for **Tuesday 11 February 2014 at 11 am**.

2. At this hearing, the Trial Chamber expects to hear focused *legal* submissions from the Prosecution, Defence counsel in both cases, the Legal Representatives for the Victims, and, if necessary the Registrar, to supplement any written submissions, concentrating on:

- any legal impediments to joining the two cases,
- the effect on the progress of the *Ayyash* trial if the cases are joined, and
- any procedural prejudice to the Defence of Mr. Merhi, including any counter-balancing measures, if the cases are joined.

3. The Registrar is invited to file any submissions by Tuesday 4 February 2014 on any relevant matters, including:

- the implications for the resources of the Special Tribunal if two trials were held in respect of the same matter (the explosion of 14 February 2005), and
- the capacity of the Special Tribunal to translate all disclosed Prosecution material into each of its three official languages, as requested by counsel for Mr. Merhi at a preliminary hearing held on 14 January 2014.<sup>2</sup>
