**DECISION GRANTING THE PROSECUTION'S MOTION (F1376) FOR VIDEO-
CONFERENCE LINK TESTIMONY OF PRH218**

(Extract from Official Public Transcript of Hearing on 4 February 2014, page 61, line 8 to
page 61, line 24)

This is in relation to the Prosecutor's urgent motion for video conference link testimony for Witness PRH128 filed on the 31st of January, 2014.

This witness is scheduled to testify this week, and the Prosecutor has filed an application to hear their testimony via video conference link. The Trial Chamber asked the Defence to respond by 12. 00 noon yesterday, that was the 3rd of February. There was no response from the counsel for Mr. Badreddine, Mr. Oneissi, and Mr. Sabra. Counsel for Mr. Ayyash filed a response objecting to the application.

The Trial Chamber is satisfied that the Prosecutor has provided good cause for the witness to testify by video conference link and we will grant the application; however, in relation to the points made by counsel for Mr. Ayyash, the Chamber will issue a short written decision in relation to those points as soon as is practicable.

So we will grant the application and ask that the Registrar make all the arrangements to hear that witness's testimony by video conference link this week.
