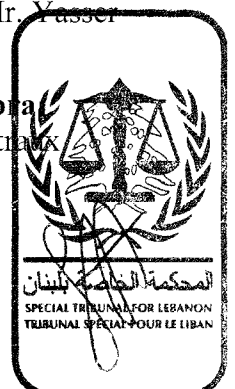

On 11 April 2014, the Prosecution filed a ‘Request for Issuance of Arrest Warrants, Orders and Requests for Transfer and Detention’,¹ requesting the Trial Chamber to annul the existing arrest warrants, orders and requests for transfer and detention against Mr. Salim Jamil Ayyash, Mr. Mustafa Amine Badreddine, Mr. Hassan Habib Merhi, Mr. Hussein Hassan Oneissi, and Mr. Assad Hassan Sabra and, on the basis of the consolidated indictment filed on 7 March 2014 to reissue them. The Pre-Trial Judge has previously—after confirming amendments to an indictment—issued new and updated arrest warrants, orders and requests to transfer and detain accused persons.²

THE TRIAL CHAMBER:

Pursuant to Rule 9 of Special Tribunal’s Rules of Procedure and Evidence,

ORDERS Defence counsel to inform the Trial Chamber by **17:30, Monday 14 April 2014**, whether they wish to respond to the motion; and, if so, to file any response by **16:00, Wednesday, 16 April 2014**.
