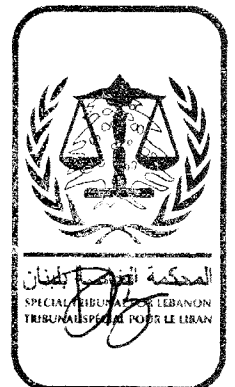

1. On 8 April 2016, I granted the Parties's request for a postponement of the deadline for submission of the Parties' final briefs and closing arguments.¹ I ordered that the final briefs be filed on 28 April 2016 and that the Parties may submit their closing arguments on 5 May 2016.
2. After consultation with the Trial Chamber, I am advised that the courtroom is not available on 5 May 2016. Accordingly, I find it appropriate to postpone the scheduling of the closing arguments to 13 May 2016 at 10.00 a.m.
3. The Parties will both have one hour to present their closing arguments, starting with the *Amicus Curiae* Prosecutor. The Parties will have 30 minutes each for their rebuttal and rejoinder arguments.
