DECISION RESCINDING THE PROTECTIVE MEASURE GRANTED TO **CONFIDENTIAL PARTICIPATING VICTIM V043**

- 1. Ms Hana Diab El-Arab, confidential participating Victim V043, now wishes to be a public participating victim. The Legal Representative of Victims filed a request¹ to the Trial Chamber on her behalf to rescind the protective measure previously granted to Ms El-Arab.² Ms El-Arab provided her written consent in a confidential annex to the request. Neither the Prosecution, nor Defence counsel objected to the request.³ The Legal Representative of Victims consented to the reclassification of the annex to the request from confidential to public.⁴
- 2. Having reviewed the motion in light of Rule 133 (A) of the Special Tribunal's Rules of Procedure and Evidence,⁵ the Trial Chamber grants the request of the Legal Representative of Victims.

DISPOSITION

FOR THESE REASONS, the Trial Chamber:

RESCINDS the protective measure granted to Ms Hana Diab El-Arab by the Pre-Trial Judge;

INSTRUCTS the Registry to reclassify the annex to the request of the Legal Representative of Victims from confidential to public.
