- 1. Public participating victims, Mr Mamdouh Mohammed Tarraf (Victim V046) and Mr Kamal Nasser (Victim V049) expressed their wish to be present during one or two public sessions in the courtroom on 27 and/or 28 September 2016. The Legal Representative of Victims filed a request to the Trial Chamber on their behalf. None of the Parties object to this request.²
- 2. The Trial Chamber has previously issued general directions on the attendance of victims in the courtroom.³ The Trial Chamber underlines that the views and concerns of victims may be presented in court by their legal representatives, in accordance with Article 17 of the Statute of the Special Tribunal. Nevertheless, following the principles of its general directions and having reviewed the motion, the Trial Chamber permits the attendance of Mr Tarraf and Mr Nasser in the courtroom during the public hearings scheduled for 27 and 28 September 2016.

DISPOSITION

FOR THESE REASONS, the Trial Chamber:

GRANTS the request of the Legal Representative of Victims; and

INSTRUCTS the Registry to make all necessary arrangements.
