

Following the submissions from the Ayyash Defence and the Prosecution on 10 and 17 March 2017,¹ the Trial Chamber instructs the Ayyash Defence to communicate with the Prosecution with a view to resolving: (i) the Ayyash Defence's unsuccessful attempts to reproduce specific call sequence tables; and (ii) the removal of some duplicate entries from the same call sequence tables.² The Trial Chamber directs the Parties to inform the Trial Chamber by the close of business on **Monday, 20 March 2017** of the steps taken to resolve the matter.
