**CONSIDERING** the "Order of the Presiding Judge to Assign Judges" issued by me on 13 June 2003 ("Order");


**CONSIDERING** that the Order while correctly stating the composition of the Appeals Chamber in this case does not list the Judges in the correct order of seniority;
