
1. On 2 April 2012, the Prosecution filed a motion seeking the transfer of the case of Ladislav Ntaganzwa to Rwanda pursuant to Rule 11 *bis* of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence.¹


2. The Registry has informed the Chamber that it has assigned Mr. Francis K. Stolla as Duty Counsel to represent the interests of the fugitive-Accused.²


FOR THESE REASONS, THE CHAMBER
