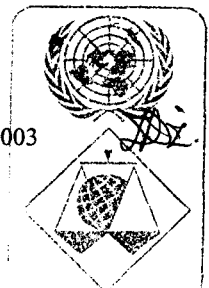

I, **FAUSTO POCAR**, Pre-Appeal Judge in this case;

**BEING SEIZED** of the “Request of Mladen Naletilić to Decision on Joint Defence Motion by Enver Hadzihasanović and Amir Kubura for Access to All Confidential Material, Filings, Transcripts and Exhibits in the Naletilić and Martinović case”, filed on 17 November 2003 by Counsel for Mladen Naletilić (“Motion”);

**NOTING** the “Decision on Joint Defence Motion by Enver Hadzihasanović and Amir Kubura for Access to All Confidential Material Filings, Transcripts and Exhibits in the Naletilić and Martinović case” issued on 7 November 2003 (“Decision”);

**NOTING** that the Decision grants Enver Hadzihasanović and Amir Kubura access to specified confidential material in the *Naletilić and Martinović* case “subject to any application by either party in the *Naletilić and Martinović* case for additional protective measures within eight working days”;

**NOTING** that in the Motion, Naletilić requests that the deadline set in the Decision be extended “until 1 December 2003, or fourteen (14) days” in order for Naletilić to have an opportunity to confer with his Counsel;

**CONSIDERING** that the opportunity for Naletilić to confer with his Counsel, in this particular case, justifies a variation of the deadline set out in the Decision;

**FOR THE FOREGOING REASONS,**

**GRANT** the Motion and **ORDER** Counsel for Naletilić to file any request for additional protective measures on or before 1 December 2003.
